

No TfL Rail service between Brentwood and Shenfield

Tuesday 3 January until late May 2017

- Slightly reduced peak service between Gidea Park and Brentwood
- Trains on the rest of the line may be busier than usual

What's happening from Tuesday 3 January 2017?

Shenfield area works

Network Rail is carrying out Crossrail construction work to improve capacity in the Shenfield area. This is to make way for new, longer trains from May 2017, and new Elizabeth line services from December 2018.

The work involves building a new platform and remodelling a major junction.

Ongoing Brentwood station works

Transport for London is carrying out improvement works including:

- New entrances to the main ticket hall and platform 4
- New ticket gates, ticket machines and accessible ticket office windows
- Improved decoration, lighting and customer information

Network Rail is also building longer platforms to make way for the new trains.

How will this affect your journey?

A frequent rail replacement bus service will run between Brentwood and Shenfield stations. The journey time will be about 6-10 minutes off-peak and 15-20 minutes during peak times.

Valid tickets will also be accepted on local bus route 81 between Brentwood and Shenfield stations (via Brentwood High Street) for connections with Greater Anglia services at Shenfield. On weekdays, The **04:44** train from Shenfield to Brentwood and the **01:32** train from Brentwood to Shenfield will continue to run.

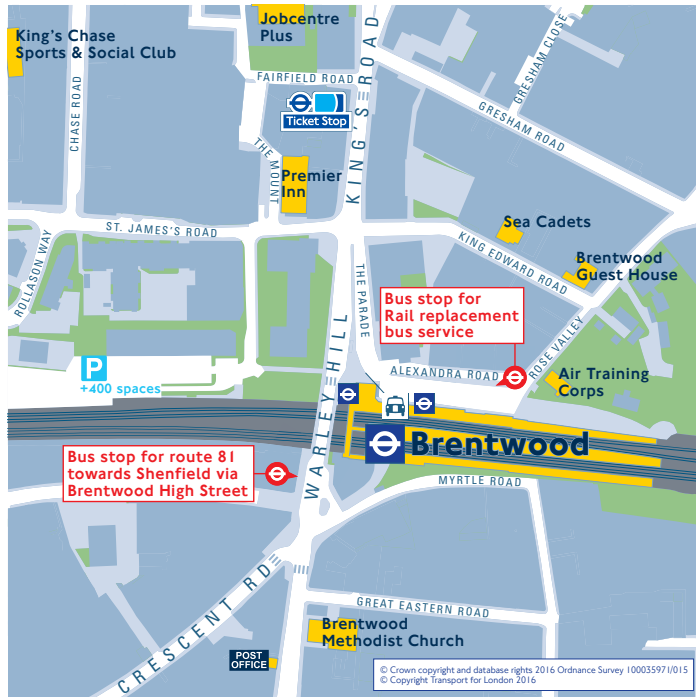
A slightly reduced peak service will run between Gidea Park and Brentwood:

- The **07:54** from Shenfield to Liverpool Street will start from Gidea Park at **08:08**
- The **18:37**, **18:57** and **19:22** trains from Liverpool Street to Shenfield will terminate at Gidea Park

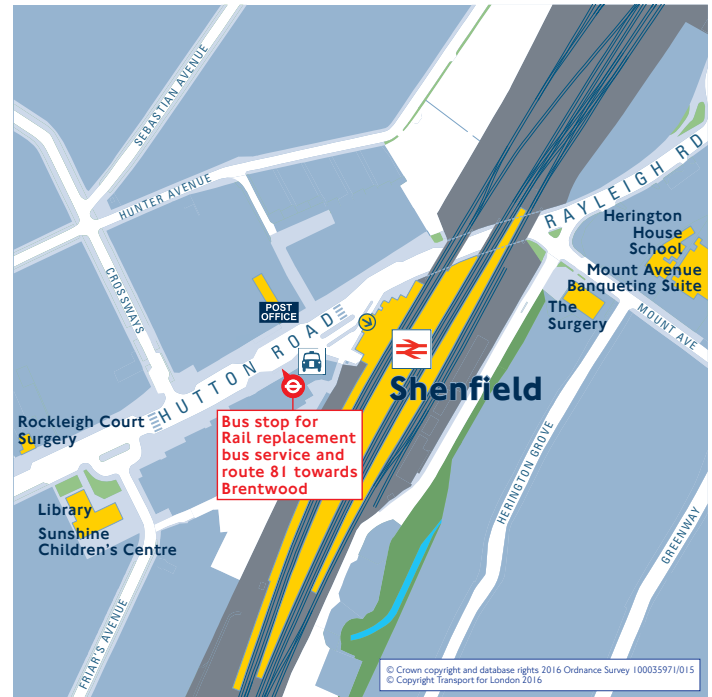
All trains will depart from and arrive at platform 4 at Brentwood station. For step-free access please use the entrance to platform 4 on The Parade.
